Flan Garry - Flan joined the Irish Air Corps in 1971. Served in Helicopter operations working on Alouette, Gazelle, Puma and Dauphin helicopters as an Airworthiness inspector from 1978 to 1992.

Joined the Department of Transport in October 1992, and transferred to the Irish Aviation Authority in November 1993. Served in all areas of the Safety & Regulatory Division of the Authority.

In 1999 appointed Aircraft Registration Officer for the Irish Aviation Authority.

To date Flan has drawn up and implemented 20 Article 83bis agreements with various ICAO contracting states including Russia Italy to Mexico and Mongolia. Responsible for the management and update of these international agreements and lodgement of same with International Civil Aviation Organization in Montreal Canada, where these international agreements are lodged for legal reasons.

From 1999 to date responsible for ICAO article 83bis agreements between Ireland and other ICAO contracting states. During this period Flan had wide contacts with the Irish leasing firms and legal firms on the development of aircraft leasing out of Ireland. Organized a number of presentations on aircraft registration in Ireland to Air Finance conferences in Europe and in Russia and to a number of leasing companies.

Since the implementation in the State of the Capetown Convention Act in March 1996, Flan is also responsible for the implementation of the Capetown Convention 'Protocol' in the state, in relation to I.D.E.R.A. (Irrevocable De-Registration and Export Request Authorisation) lodgement and revocation etc. by the Irish Aviation Authority.
