What Turnitin *is*?

- ▶ Text matching software with access to
 - Over **12** Billion Web Pages Crawled & Archived
 - Over **90** Million Student Papers
 - Over **12,000** Major Newspapers, Magazines & Scholarly Journals
 - Thousands Of Books Including Literary Classics
- ▶ Produces **originality report**, which needs to be interpreted by the examiner

What Turnitin *is not*?

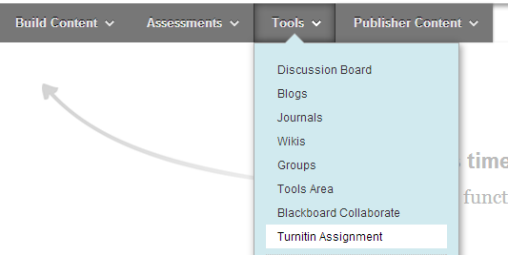
- ▶ Does not detect plagiarism
- ▶ Does not check ALL published material
- ▶ Not the panacea to 'cure' all plagiarism related problems

Good Practice in using Turnitin

- ▶ Holistic approach
 - should be used as one of many tools to deter plagiarism
- ▶ **Need consistent approach to use**
 - otherwise misconduct is reinforced
- ▶ **Allow students at least one revision submission with access to their originality report before final submission**
- ▶ **Train ALL users**
 - provide supporting information for students
 - include syllabus statement explaining use of Turnitin
 - inform students openly about use
 - remove unique student identifiers from submissions
